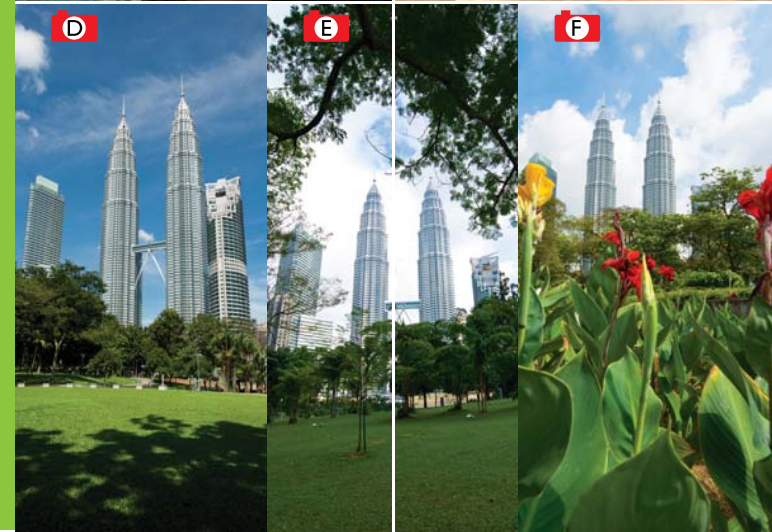

A SHOWCASE OF TROPICAL GREENERY

Conceived as a 'Work of Art', the KLCC Park was designed by world-renowned Brazilian landscape artist, the late Roberto Burle Marx. An interesting element of the KLCC Park is the centrally located 43-metre elevated bridge, which provides a vantage view of the magnificent PETRONAS Twin Towers.
